Description of property:

This property consists of rolling hills with steep, rocky outcrops, mature hardwood ridges, mature white pine conifer stands, and a power line right of way passing through it.

Location/Access/Parking:

Access to this property is off of Coy Hill Road and Route 9. Route 9 parking consists only of small pullouts. Coy Hill Road has many spaces for parking.

Hunting Opportunities:

The habitat provides hunting opportunities for White-tailed Deer, Bobcat, Eastern Coyote, Raccoon, and Gray Squirrel.

Wildlife Viewing and Other Features:

This area supports many species of wildlife along with scenic overlooks to the Ware River Valley from the rocky ledge areas.
