Description of property:

This WMA is primarily a white oak and pitch pine forest featuring a mature canopy, intermittent acorn crop, and a sparse understory.

Location/Access/Parking

There is a small area of parking off of Route 130.

Hunting Opportunities

This area provides sufficient cover for upland game species such as Gray Squirrel, Eastern Cottontail, Wild Turkey, White-tailed Deer, and Eastern Coyote. This parcel does abut major roads and residences so proper hunter safety distances must be practiced.
